

2025 Senior Concert Note #2

The Nutcracker & Through the Night Sky (Grades 4 & Above – Ballet and Contemporary)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Please take the time to read this note carefully, as it contains details you need regarding the PSB End-of-Year Concerts for our Senior students.

SUNDAY REHEARSALS (COMPULSORY)

- THROUGH THE NIGHT SKY (Contemporary): Sunday, 9 November @ JOLIMONT STUDIOS
- THE NUTCRACKER (Act 1): Sunday, 16 November @ JOLIMONT STUDIOS
- THE NUTCRACKER (Act 2): Sunday, 23 November @ JOLIMONT STUDIOS

These full-act rehearsals are essential, as they're the only opportunity to rehearse with the full cast before getting to the theatre. *Please see below for rehearsal times*.

DRESS REHEARSALS (COMPULSORY) - SUNDAY 30 NOVEMBER & WEDNESDAY 3 DECEMBER

All Senior Concert students are required to attend the Dress Rehearsals at Marist Auditorium, Newman College, Churchlands on Sunday 30 November and Wednesday 3 December.

- Sunday 30 November is a Dress Rehearsal correct hair and costumes required @ MARIST AUDITORIUM, NEWMAN COLLEGE
- Wednesday 3 December is a FULL Dress Rehearsal correct hair, makeup, and costumes are required @ MARIST AUDITORIUM, NEWMAN COLLEGE

Please ensure ALL aspects of hair and costume are correct including tights, shoes and headpieces.

Please allow ample time to get to the school, park, find the theatre, and locate the dressing room that your child is in, and check them in with the parent on roster.

Students should arrive with hair and makeup done. Parents are not permitted to stay in the changeroom unless they have volunteered as a helper. (If you'd like to volunteer, please see sign-up sheets at reception at Osborne Park or Jolimont studios in the coming weeks.) Students are NOT allowed to leave before the completion of their rehearsal time as we will often run through everything twice. At the end of the rehearsal please wait in the dressing rooms until you are called to assemble on stage (both students and parents) to receive any costume notes. Please be prompt for pick-up as we need to keep to our rehearsal schedule and allocated times at the theatre. Please see below for rehearsal times.



PARENT HELPERS - CONCERT REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES

Our dress rehearsals and performances require parent volunteers to assist with changeroom supervision and costume changes. Parent helpers must stay in the changerooms for the duration of the rehearsal/performance to assist all students, not just their own child.

Each class is to have parents rostered to dress and care for students in dressing rooms until the end of their Act for each performance and rehearsal. Please fill in your name on the rosters that will be available on the reception desks in the coming weeks.

In addition to having parents to supervise in the changerooms, we also need some helpers backstage for the students who have quick changes. If you are available to help, please sign up at the front desk.

Male Volunteers:

For privacy reasons, male volunteers are asked to assist in the boys' changeroom or with other backstage support roles (such as helping side stage or front of house), rather than in the girls' dressing areas.

COSTUMES - NO STUDENTS TO ARRIVE AT OR LEAVE THE THEATRE IN COSTUME

- No consumption of food or drinks while in costume. (And please don't bring foods containing nuts due to allergies.)
- All costumes and belongings must be clearly labelled with the student's name.
- Costumes should be stored in suit covers.
- All students require clean pink ballet tights and shoes.
- No knickers to be worn under tights.

No lost costumes, headpieces or accessories will be able to be replaced by PSB, so a large washing basket (clearly labelled) is suggested to be used by all students in more than 1 dance. All personal items can quickly be placed in each student's basket and kept in one place.

Parents are asked to make a check list of everything dancers will need i.e.: costumes, hats, spare tights, shoes, props, hair supplies and make-up – you will be receiving a costume note with these details on it.

Some students will be hiring costumes. Please make sure any hired costumes are washed (or drycleaned if required) prior to return.

Costumes are currently in the process of being organised. You will be advised when the balance of your costume costs are available on your child's JackRabbit portal & when payments will be deducted.

Costumes will be distributed in class before the Dress rehearsals.

Please ensure your term fees and costume payments are up to date, as costumes cannot be handed out to families with outstanding balances.



THEATRE RULES

- No parents backstage except during drop-off/pick-up or if rostered as a helper.
- No food or drink to be taken into the theatre.
- No running or touching theatre equipment backstage.
- Students must co-operate with theatre staff and parent helpers at all times.
- No photos or videos are to be taken during performances.
- The Sunday & Wednesday Theatre Rehearsals are closed rehearsals. No viewing permitted.

HAIR AND MAKEUP

If you'd like some visual help, our lovely former students **Emily and Bella** have created tutorial videos on our YouTube channel *The Perth School of Ballet* demonstrating both hair and makeup techniques.

All dances require high bun - no part - no fringes.

Please ensure hair is slick, secure, and performance ready.

Stage Makeup

All students are to wear **full makeup** as follows:

- Foundation (pancake type recommended; not too dark)
- Face powder
- Rouge (rose brown)
- Eyeshadow (browns & creams)
- Mascara (black)
- False Eyelashes
- Lip liner
- Lipstick (red)

	Helpful Hints for Buns
Step 1	 Brush hair neatly into high ponytail.
	 Use gel or hairspray to make sure there are no untidy hair wispies.
	Make sure fringe is back off face.
Step 2	Twist ponytail gently & wrap into doughnut shape. Push flat against head. DO NOT USE A BUN DOUGHNUT
Step 3	Take hair net or bun net (can be purchased at chemist or hair sections in stores like Big W) and place over bun.
Step 4	 Use bun clips which are V shaped to clip around edge of bun to head. Use a minimum of 12 clips evenly around bun (think of a clock)





Saturday 6 December - only adult classes running


PERFORMANCE DETAILS - Friday, 5 December and Saturday, 6 December

Performances are at Marist Auditorium, Newman College.

The performance on **Friday, 5 December begins at 6:00pm** and the performance on **Saturday, 6 December begins at 12:30pm**. All students perform in BOTH shows!

Please note that Newman College is still in session. Please be mindful of this when arriving on Friday evening at 4pm. There may still be many Newman College students and staff around.

As for rehearsals, please allow ample time to get to the school, park, find the theatre, and locate the dressing room that your child is in, and check them in with the parent on roster. Please drop off your children BEFORE their Act starts and pick them up from their dressing room AFTER it has finished, unless they have chosen to be in the FINALE (see note under Sunday Rehearsal 23 November).

\$20 per single performer | \$30 per family (two or more performers).


With all families contributing to the cost of recording, every family will receive access to *all* concert recordings (Junior & Senior).

Streamlined Administration

The concert video fee will be **automatically deducted** from your nominated account at the same time as your costume balance. (Date to be advised.) No order form or opt-in required.

Please note: While PSB is happy to facilitate having Polish'D Productions at our rehearsal, we do not profit from the sale of recordings.






CONCERT TICKET SALES
