As we are now in Term 3, we wanted to ensure to give you all the information you will need regarding our end of year concert held in Term 4.

Please note, there is a great deal of important information below, including costs & timing of payments. Please make sure you read this so that you have all the information you require.

Concert time at PSB is an exciting time. You'll notice the buzz as preparations begin and students start work on their concert dances. It's a welcome addition to their class work and they all look forward to it. We make sure almost all preparations happen during class time.

Each year we hold 2 concerts: A Junior Concert and a Senior Concert.

Junior Concert: Saturday, 03 December, 1.00pm

Senior Concert: Friday, 02 December (Evening 6pm)

Saturday, 03 December (Evening 5pm)

Your child will be performing in the Junior Concert.

The Concert is held at the Marist Auditorium at Newman College in Churchlands.

Important Details

Our younger students love to be part of the buzz and excitement of our concert. Their performance will be held on **Saturday, 03 December.** Our senior concerts have two performances (on Friday & Saturday) giving our young students the chance to watch the Senior performance if they so choose.

Kindy, Pre-Primary, Primary, Ballet Foundation & Grade 1 students will perform one dance per class in the Junior Concert. (If your child is in one class, they will perform one dance, if they are in two classes, they will perform two dances).

The following schedule is for our Junior Concert students:

- **A Dress Rehearsal will be held on Sunday 27 November at our Osborne Park Studios** . Your child will be required for approximately 90mins per dance between 9.00am to approximately 1.00pm on Sunday 27 November. You will be advised of your time slot in Term 4.
- **Theatre Rehearsal and Performance on Saturday 03 December** . Times to be confirmed but will complete no later than 2.00pm.

The Concert is held at the Marist Auditorium at Newman College in Churchlands.

Concert Costumes

All students will require a costume for their dance. To make things as easy as possible, we have all costumes made and fitted for each student. In most cases, costumes will be given to parents almost complete (some gluing or decorating may be required). We endeavour to keep the costs as low as possible.

Overall Concert Costs

Concert Costume Cost

\$70 per costume (maximum 2 costumes if performing in 2 dances).

Studio Dress Rehearsal and Concert Day Rehearsal Costs

\$35 per child (this total cost will be added to your Term 4 fees).

Commencing Thursday, 1 September your costume fee of \$70.00 will be deducted from your nominated account.

IMPORTANT NOTE

If your child does not intend to participate in the end of year concert, you must email PSB Business Manager, Christine Daniels (info@perthschoolofballet.com.au), to notify her **by no later than Saturday 27 August.** *If you do not notify Christine that your child is not participating by the date above, the costume cost will be deducted from your account.*

We understand that this is a lot to take in. But we are certain your child will love the experience of being part of our Junior concert. They learn what it's like to be part of a large production and they are always amazed to see (and be part of) the end result. Though it can be hard work for everyone (not the least – for parents!) the consensus is usually that it was worth it in the end.
